Our oceans are becoming extremely(55). Most of this pollution comes from the land,			
which means it comes from(56). Firstly, there is raw sewage, which is pumped directly into			
the sea. Many(57), both developed and developing, are guilty of doing this. Secondly, ships			
drop about 6 millions tons of(58) into the sea each year. Thirdly, there are oil spills from
